

The Durovent Baffle attic ventilation system is the most economical way to ventilate your roof and block out the wind and rain! A water resistant baffle is incorporated into the Number ONE selling vent in the industry allowing for a one-step rafter vent and baffle installation. Installation of the Durovent Baffle eliminates the need for using blocking material such as batt insulation between the vent and the wall top plate, as is commonly the practice for installation of rafter vents without an integral baffle. Durovent Baffles are a great choice for 24" on-center applications and can be cut to fit smaller rafter spacing. Made in the U.S.A.

HOW MANY VENTS DO I NEED?

Poor air flow reduces insulation efficiencies and accelerates problems due to moisture. Without ventilation channels, air cannot flow freely from the soffit to the exhaust vents. We recommend installing at least one vent per rafter or truss cavity. Some applications may require multiple vents overlapped to extend the ventilation cavity beyond obstructions, such as knee walls.

REQUIRED TOOLS

- Staple Gun or Hammer Tacker
- Ladder (for new construction)
- Utility Knife (if cutting is needed)

INSTALLING DUROVENT BAFFLE in 24" O.C. CONSTRUCTION -

1. Place the vent against the roof deck - tucking sides between the truss.



4. Staple vent to roof deck every 6-8 inches using the provided channels to further secure the vent.



2. Slide down toward soffit and allow the baffle to fold onto the top plate.



5. At the top plate, staple the bottom of the vent to the top plate. Tuck in sides and staple to each truss.



3. Secure vent by stapling every 6-8 inches along each truss.



6. You are finished with the Durovent Baffle installation and ready to begin insulating your attic.



INSTALLING DUROVENT BAFFLE IN 16" O.C. CONSTRUCTION

 Use a utility knife to cut vent along the length of the vent as indicated by the "cut here" marking on the vent.



2. Overlap two parts and fit into rafter cavity. Secure vent following steps above.
